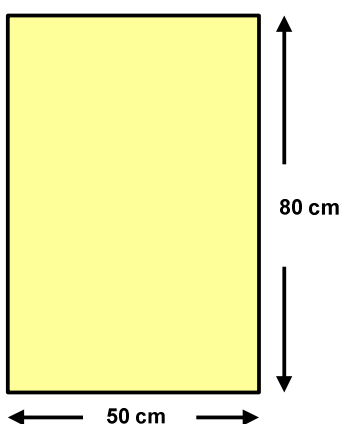


GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

Your poster is an advertisement for your ideas, findings and techniques and needs to attract readers from a distance in a sea of other displays. This guideline has been prepared, first of all, for authors with little experience at the scientific conferences. It is hoped that this leaflet will help to have uniformly high-level presentations at the Student Poster Session, Innovations 2007.

Preparation of Posters



- Posters should be simple, brief and prepared having in mind, primarily, their use as a basis for the presentation. However, they should be also self-intelligible.
- The information may conveniently be divided into sections, starting with an Introduction and ending with Conclusion.
- As poster should be readable by more than one person at the same time, a letter size of at least 6 mm in height for the text and 10 mm for the section headings are suggested.

Poster Board Dimensions

- Each poster presentation must have a title including the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), city and country)
- Any necessary equipment for attaching the sheets to the board will be available near the poster location. Please use only the provided materials in order not to damage the panels and enable a smooth removal afterwards.

Other Remarks

- An author is expected to be at the poster location during the presentation time assigned for the relevant poster session. This time will be specified in the Final Programme of the conference, together with the time assigned for putting up and taking down the posters.
- Please note there will be no session chairpersons for the poster discussions.
